

By letter dated August 15, 1983, Duke advised the NRC of a situation at Oconee Unit 1 wherein two items, required by the Confirmatory Order concerning certain post-TMI actions dated March 18, 1983, had not been implemented during the recent refueling outage. These two items are the post-accident sampling system and the RB high range radiation monitor.

This situation was discussed in a conference call on August 16, 1983 with representatives of both ONRR and Region II. Confirming this discussion, Duke commits to submit by August 26, 1983, a letter to the NRC which describes the plan, including schedule, by which Duke will resolve and effectively implement the two items required by the Order which were not completed during the recent Unit 1 outage.
