Dear Sir:

Duke Power Company hereby requests an extension of time for responding to Sections 2.2.1.5 and 2.2.2 of Generic Letter 83-28 which was dated July 8, 1983. The reasons for requesting these extensions are as follows.

Section 2.2.1.5

This section requires a demonstration of appropriate design verification, qualification testing, procurement control, and receipt of limits-of-life test documentation for safety-related components. The response for this item will be common for all three of Duke's nuclear stations and requires a thorough interdepartmental review of a draft position which is presently being developed. January 15, 1984 is proposed as the date for submitting Duke's response on this section to the NRC.

Section 2.2.2

This section contains requirements for licensee submittals describing vendor interface programs for safety-related components. To assist in meeting these requirements, Duke Power Company has established an active membership in a Nuclear Utility Task Action Committee (NUTAC) which was formed on September 1, 1983 for the specific purpose of defining alternative industry vendor interface programs. Duke Power feels the work to be done by this NUTAC should be an integral part of individual utilities future vendor interface programs.

While participating in the NUTAC we will continue to utilize the INPO sponsored programs SEE-IN and NPRDS supplemented by our present in-house program for vendor interface on each of the Duke nuclear stations. Duke Power feels that this requested time extension will have no impact on the safe operation of its nuclear stations. After completion of the NUTAC's effort we will submit our resultant Duke specific program description for vendor interface to the NRC.


