By letter dated December 26, 1985, the NRC provided for our response a status report on Multiplant Action C-14 regarding the Oconee Emergency Feedwater (EFW) System and requested Duke to either provide a commitment to resolve the open items or appeal to NRR management to have the staff's position modified.
