Duke Power has implemented a new Emergency Operations Facility (EOF) for Oconee Nuclear Station as of July 1. As yet, the NRC Emergency Notification System (Red Phone) has not been installed. However, we have not delayed our implementation because of this. We have been working with Mr. Stuart Cohen of the Telecommunications Branch at NRC Headquarters to install the system at the new EOF. Because of the distance between the old and new EOF's, the circuit has to be re-engineered.

This request was originally made to Mr. Cohen in late March, with a requested completion date of May 23. Because of problems the work has not yet been completed. We will continue to work with Mr. Cohen to assure a timely resolution of problems and implementation of the notification system. In the interim, communications with the NRC, in the event of an emergency, will be handled over commercial telephone lines.
