Purpose of the Meeting: The purpose of the meeting was to discuss and receive comments regarding the preliminary draft regulatory guide associated with the standard format and content for licensing applications for hexafluoride source material facilities (see the meeting agenda available at the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System [ADAMS] Accession No. ML16124B037).

General Details:

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) held a Category 3 public meeting on May 26, 2016 from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time. Seven NRC staff members participated by phone, along with three Honeywell Metropolis Works staff, and one staff member from the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI).

The meeting began with an introduction to the preliminary draft regulatory guide (see ADAMS Accession No. ML16074A269). The meeting was then opened to members of the public to receive any questions or comments on the preliminary draft. Two members of the public provided comments (see below). The meeting ended after all interested participants had a chance to ask questions or make comments.

During the meeting, the NRC staff received comments and questions in the following general areas:

- Regulatory Guide Publication Process
 - When will the official public comment period be held?
 - How long will the public comment period be?
 - When will the final Regulatory Guide be issued?

- References to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 70/Integrated Safety Analysis (ISA)
 - The 10 CFR Part 40 ISA rule was never finalized; is the NRC trying to regulate through the regulatory guide?
 - Will the old format for applications still be acceptable?

Action Items/Next Steps:

The NRC staff will keep Honeywell Metropolis Works and NEI apprised of the schedule for the public comments period and eventual release of Regulatory Guide 3.55.
