In order for the NRC to adequately prepare for this inspection, please furnish the operating tests scheduled for the week of the inspection to the NRC by August 17, 1994.

The request for requalification examination material is covered by Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Clearance Number 3150-0101, which expires on October 31, 1995. The estimated average burden is 4.0 hours per response, including gathering, copying, and mailing the required material.
