

Status of Recommendations

Recommendation 4: Procure a secure fax maintenance support contract that specifies maintenance performance standards and links these standards to vendor compensation.

Agency Response
Dated May 25, 2016: The NRC staff developed and executed a secure fax maintenance contract with specific goal-oriented tasks. The contract supports the entire secure fax inventory for multiple years beyond the 1-year contract period. The contract was awarded April 25, 2016. The contract number is GS35F051, task order NRC-HQ-11-16-T-001.

OIG Analysis: OIG spoke with the Point of Contact regarding the executed contract and determined that the contract includes the maintenance performance standards that were needed and links the standards to vendor compensation. This recommendation is therefore considered closed.
