SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR WITHHOLDING INFORMATION FROM PUBLIC DISCLOSURE
OF SUPPORT DOCUMENTS FOR THE SAFETY EVALUATION OF THE
MELTAC PLATFORM TOPICAL REPORT (TAC NO. MF4882)

Dear Mr. Remley:

By letter dated June 6, 2016 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Package Accession No. ML16158A193), Mitsubishi Electric Corporation (MELCO) submitted an affidavit executed by Shigeru Sugitani, Senior Manager, Control and Protection Systems Section on May 31, 2016, requesting that the information contained in the following documents be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR), Part 2, Section 2.390:

- JEXU-1041-10120-P(R1), "Mapping of MELTAC Platform Licensing Documents to the DI&C-ISG-06 Guidance,"
- JEXU-1041-1022-P(R1), "Summary of MELTAC Platform Design."
- JEXU-1041-1026-P(R2), "Summary of MELTAC Platform V&V," and
- JEXU-1041-1027-P(R1), "Summary of MELTAC Platform Reliability."

Nonproprietary versions of these documents can be found in the ADAMS package referenced above.

The reasons for withholding the information from public disclosure are detailed in the affidavit submitted by MELCO (ADAMS Accession No. ML16158A195).

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff has reviewed your application and the material in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.390, and on the basis of the statements in the affidavit, has determined that the submitted information sought to be withheld contains proprietary commercial information, and should be withheld from public disclosure.

Therefore, the version(s) of the submitted information marked as proprietary will be withheld from public disclosure under 10 CFR 2.390(b)(5) and Section 103(b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended.

Withholding from public inspection shall not affect the right, if any, of persons properly and directly concerned to inspect the documents. If the need arises, the agency may send copies of this information to its consultants working in this area. The NRC staff will, of course, ensure that the consultants have signed the appropriate agreements for handling proprietary information.
