

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Dear Mr. O'Reilly:

With regard to your letter dated August 29, 1979 which transmitted IE Bulletin 29-18, a survey of the Oconee Nuclear Station paging system was conducted. All three containments, two of which were operating, and all areas of the auxiliary and turbine building, with the exception of two very high radiation areas, were surveyed. The results of this survey indicate that several modifications to the system are required. These include additional speakers in selected areas, re-positioning/relocation of existing speakers, and repair of existing equipment. The results of this survey will be verified for Oconee 3 areas following restart from its refueling outage.

For accessible areas, corrective actions required will be completed by December 27, 1979. For inaccessible areas, the corrective actions will be completed at the next available outage of sufficient duration following receipt of required materials. Presently, an expected delivery date for these materials is not available.
