SUBJECT: USE OF IMPROPER STEAM GENERATOR MANWAY GASKETS

During hydrostatic testing of the Unit 1 Reactor Coolant System (RCS) following refueling, the licensee discovered leakage of approximately sixty drops per minute from one of the manway gaskets on steam generator "A". RCS pressure was 500 psi at the time. Investigation revealed that a flexatallic gasket with a pressure rating of 900 psi had been installed instead of the required 2500 psi rating. Further investigation revealed that improper gaskets had also been installed on all steam generator manways in Units 1 and 3 and on the upper narways in Unit 2. The licensee suspects that the wrong gaskets have been in use since 1978 when they received a shipment of new gaskets from Babcock-Wilcox although, there has not been any evidence of leakage in the past. The licensee is pursuing the cause of the supply problem as well as the predicted failure mode of the gaskets with Eabcock-Wilcox and Flexatallic companies. They are also evaluating the effect on Units 2 and 3, which are both operating at this time.

Media interest has not occurred. Neither the licensee nor the NRC plans to issue a press release at this time. The State of South Carolina has been notified.
