

Dear Sir:

Your letter dated November 14, 1980, which transmitted IE Bulletin 80-23, requested a submittal from the licensee within 45 days describing longer term corrective actions and the date by which the corrective actions will be implemented. In response to your request, Duke Power Company will replace the Valcor solenoid valves at the Oconee Nuclear Station with fully qualified Asco solenoid valves. The valves which will be replaced were identified in my letter of November 24, 1980 concerning this Bulletin. The Asco solenoid valves have been purchased per the applicable requirements of IEEE-323-1974, IEEE-344-1975, and IEEE-383-1972. Duke Power expects to receive the Asco solenoid valves around the end of January 1981. The Asco valves will be installed as soon as possible after receipt.
