Dear Ms. Wylie:

On June 10, 2016, NEI submitted Revision 1 of guidance document NEI 16-05, "External Flooding Assessment Guidelines" for NRC review and endorsement. This submittal supports NRC's 50.54(f) request letter (Reference 1) by providing guidance on the completion of flooding hazard focused evaluations and integrated assessments. NEI understands that the NRC endorsement of this revision to NEI 16-05 would be through an issuance of the final interim staff guidance (ISG), JLD-ISG-2016-01.

NEI requests that the NRC's review of NEI 16-05 and any future submissions of the guidance document be granted a fee waiver pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 170.11. The report meets the exemption requirement in 10 CFR 170.11(a)(1)(iii) in that it is "a means of exchanging information between industry organizations and the NRC...for the specific purpose of supporting ongoing NRC generic regulatory improvements or efforts." In this case, the revision of this guidance supports increased regulatory efficiency of agency efforts as it provides a consistent industry approach for on the completion of flooding hazard focused evaluations and integrated assessments per NRC's 50.54(f) request letter (Reference 1).
