SUBJECT: AMENDMENT 74 TO SNM-2010 - APPROVAL OF LICENSE AMENDMENT REQUEST 16-03, REVISION OF ENRICHMENT TECHNOLOGY COMPANY STANDARD PRACTICE PROCEDURE PLAN AND INCORPORATION OF OTHER NON-SUBSTANTIVE PAGE CHANGES (COST ACTIVITY CODE L34360)

Dear Mr. Thyne:

By letter dated February 29, 2016 (LES-16-00041-NRC), Louisiana Energy Services, LLC (LES), dba URENCO USA (UUSA), requested that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) review and approve a revised UUSA Standard Practice Procedure Plan (SPPP) for the Protection of Classified Matter (Agencywide Document Access and Management System [ADAMS] Accession No. ML16064A024). This revision of the SPPP (Revision 15) would replace the existing licensing basis document listed in its materials license SNM-2010, License Condition 10h.

By letter February 16, 2016 (ML16053A006), UUSA also submitted non-substantive page changes to the SPPP protection of classified matter. These changes were submitted prior to the submittal of LAR 16-03, so that UUSA remained in compliance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) 95.19(b), which requires non-substantive changes to be submitted to the NRC within 30 days of implementation of such changes. That version of the SPPP was implemented by UUSA security on February 1, 2016.

The staff has completed its review of the above submittals, and finds that the proposed changes are in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 95.15, and do not decrease the effectiveness of either SPPP. Therefore, both license amendment request 16-03 and the non-substantive changes discussed above are approved and subparagraph h to License Condition 10 of SNM-2010 will be amended as follows:

- h. Standard Practice Procedure Plan (SPPP) for the Protection of Classified Matter dated December 12, 2003, as revised by correspondence dated July 30, 2004; March 16, 2006; November 21, 2006; November 22, 2006; March 20, 2007; April 27, 2007; July 19, 2007; October 12, 2007; November 30, 2007; February 4, 2008; May 1, 2008; May 7, 2008; June 26, 2008; July 7, 2008; August 4, 2008; September 4, 2008; September 5, 2008; October 6, 2008; October 16, 2008; November 20, 2008; November 25, 2008;

The above changes are documented in Amendment 74 (enclosed) to Materials License SNM-2010.

Because all the activities noted above involve administrative actions, the NRC staff determined that the proposed activities do not individually or cumulatively have a significant effect on the human environment. Therefore, in accordance with 10 CFR 51.22(c)(11), neither an Environmental Assessment nor an Environmental Impact Statement is warranted for this action.
