

Dear Sir:

This will respond to each item of instruction listed in Appendix A, Notice of Violation, as requested.

- 1. Mr. Larry K. McKinney, P.E. is designated as Radiation Safety Officer and has served in this capacity since Mr. Saylor resigned employment with the company. Mr. McKinney attended Troxler Electronics Laboratories, Inc. nuclear gauge training course on January 16, 1992 as discussed with Mr. Richard Gibson. A copy of Mr. McKinney's Troxler Training Certificate was faxed to Mr. Gibson on January 28, 1992 upon receipt.
- 2. In the event a change in the Radiation Safety Officer designated under the license is made, notification to the USNRC of the change will be the responsibility of the current individual named Radiation Safety Officer in the license. This person is, we believe, most aware of the NRC requirements and importance of providing notification.
- 3. Compliance, we believe, occurred when Mr. McKinney assumed the responsibility of the Radiation Safety Officer at the time Mr. Saylor left the company, since there has been continuity of the activities and role provided by an RSO. Mr. McKinney had received radiation safety training from Seamans Nuclear Corporation in 1986 and has by education knowledge of nuclear physics and health considerations. The inspection found the equipment to be stored, tracked and serviced to NRC requirements. As noted, Mr. McKinney, also received Troxler gauge training as requested by the NRC.



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We regret the notification oversight to the NRC and commit to immediate notification in the event the Radiation Safety Officer is changed in the future. Please advised if any additional assistance or information is needed in regard to the above.
