This letter documents the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff's plan to perform an inspection of Namco to review implementation of your quality assurance program in accordance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 50, Appendix B and 10 CFR Part 21. Specifically, the quality assurance program and Part 21 implementation will be reviewed as it pertains to Namco's design, qualification, fabrication, testing, commercial grade dedication, and manufacturing of safety related limit switches for operating nuclear plants and AP1000 plants. As discussed by conference call on June 15, 2016, the inspectors plan to arrive at your Elizabethtown, NC facility, on Monday, July 11, 2016, and will conduct the inspection through Friday, July 15, 2016. Subsequent to the inspection, a report will be issued and transmitted to you via letter.
