Dear Erica,

American Nuclear Insurers (ANI) confirms that it will write nuclear liability insurance for Florida Power & Light Company covering Turkey Point Units 6 and 7 concurrent with the effective date that the NRC issues them a Combined License (COL).

Currently, ANI insures Turkey Point Units 3 and 4 under nuclear energy liability Facility Form Policy No. NF -0185, issued to Florida Power & Light Company. The Facility Form policy has a limit of liability of \$375 million. This policy provides primary financial protection as required under Section 170 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended. Turkey Point Units 6 and 7 would also be covered under this policy concurrent with the effective date that the NRC issues the COL.
