Dear Mr. Gresham:

By letter dated June 8, 2016 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System Accession No. ML16162A752), Westinghouse Electric Company (Westinghouse) requested a 24-month suspension of the review of WCAP-15942-P-A/WCAP-15942-NP-A, Supplement 1, Revision 1, "Material Changes for SVEA-96 Optima2 Fuel Assemblies," topical report (TR). In 24 months Westinghouse is planning to submit additional irradiation test data and a letter requesting that the NRC resume its evaluation of this TR. At this time NRC will be closing the original TAC No. ME4700 to ensure that no additional hours are charged to Westinghouse. A new number will be opened in order to resume the NRC review after Westinghouse submits the data and letter requesting continuation of the review.
