Enclosed is an application dated March 19, 2016, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) from Enrichment Technology US Inc., requesting Amendment No. 01 to export license XCOM1209 for the export of defective or malfunctioning components and subassemblies for Gas Centrifuge Enrichment to their original manufacturers in the Netherlands, the United Kingdom, and Germany for repair, replacement or disposition.

The purpose of this amendment is to: 1) change the addresses of the "Ultimate Foreign Consignee(s);" 2) change the licensee point of contact; and 3) extend the date of expiration from August 24, 2022 to August 24, 2026.

Since there are no changes to the terms and conditions of the existing license being requested, our office is processing this as a minor amendment. Therefore, the NRC intends to issue the license after the required 30-day review period.
