I wanted to reach out to you before I sent a revised recommendation to SHPO. Since we are not able to get photographs of Site 3 and 4, I am planning to revise our recommendation for these two sites to "Not eligible" but to recommend voluntary avoidance. If voluntary avoidance is not possible then NRC will recommend that the applicant voluntarily mitigate effects and seek tribal oversight during licensed activities that may impact these two sites. Please let me know if you have any concerns with this path. Otherwise, I would like to continue with the process and revised recommendation to SHPO.
