The NRC is finalizing a license amendment for Watts Bar Nuclear Plant, Unit 2. Per 10 CFR 50.91(b), 10 CFR 50.91(b)(3) and (b)(4), we are notifying you of the proposed issuance. This amendment revises the license to permit use of the Fuel Rod Performance and Design 4 Thermal Conductivity Degradation (PAD4TCD) computer program for the second cycle of plant operation.

The licensee's submittal dated December 31, 2015, is available in ADAMS under Accession No. ML15365A595.

The amendment was noticed in the Federal Register on March 1, 2016 (81 FR 10682). See the attachment to this email.
