We reviewed your letter dated June 17, 2016, transmitting Revision 20.A to your Emergency Plan. We find the changes to be acceptable. Specifically, we find that Nuclear Fuel Services, Inc. was authorized to make the changes without prior U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) approval pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR), Section 70.32. Safety Condition S-6 in your license will be updated during the next license amendment.

This action did not require a detailed technical review and a Cost Accounting Control number was not assigned to it. This action is considered **CLOSED**.
