
Reference: NUREG 1843 Supplement 1, "Safety Evaluation Report Related to the  
License Renewal of Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant Units 1, 2, and 3," dated April 2006

The referenced Safety Evaluation identified the commitments to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) that are required to be completed prior to Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant, (BFN) Unit 3, entering the period of extended operation (POE) on July 2, 2016. BFN, Unit 3, License Condition 2.E states, in part, that certain future activities to be completed prior to the POE shall be completed no later than July 2, 2016, and that the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) shall notify the NRC in writing when implementation of these activities is complete and can be verified by NRC inspection.

Accordingly, TVA has completed the activities associated with commitments specified in the referenced safety evaluation required for entry into POE.
