SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF THE JUNE 8, 2016, PUBLIC MEETING WITH  
WATER REMEDIATION TECHNOLOGY REGARDING  
RENEWAL OF WRT's MATERIAL LICENSE, NO. SUC-1591

Background

On June 8, 2016, a Category 1 public meeting was held between U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff and representatives of Water Remediation Technology (WRT, the licensee) via telecom from NRC headquarters in Two White Flint North, 11545 Rockville Pike, Rockville, Maryland and the Denver Marriott City Center, 1701 California Street, Denver, Colorado. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss renewal of WRT's NRC Source Material License, No. SUC-1591. WRT's current license expires January 25, 2017.

The meeting notice can be found in the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) under Accession No. ML16146A706. A list of attendees is provided in Enclosure 1.

Meeting

On June 8, 2016, the NRC staff held a public meeting with WRT to discuss submittal of their license action request regarding renewal of their NRC Source Material License. During the meeting, representatives from WRT gave a presentation on their strategy and timeline. This presentation is provided as Enclosure 2 and can be found in ADAMS at Accession No. ML16189A307.

During the meeting, WRT gave a current status of their water treatment systems and lessons learned from initial license term. WRT focused on existing license conditions which WRT will

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likely request NRC to review and consider deleting based on WRT having no control over the location of a treatment site, therefore, license conditions related to siting seem inappropriate. WRT will also propose to continue with the same format for financial assurance that was approved for the original license: 1) WRT's Client CWSs may provide the financial assurance arrangement on behalf of WRT, the licensee, and 2) In the case of a government-entity CWS, the CWS can use a Statement of Intent as one of the allowed arrangements
