1. Project Title

Systematic Human Performance Data Collection

2. Background

The primary objective of this task order is to systematically collect human performance data for critical tasks in nuclear power plant (NPP) control rooms using the NRC-provided simulator. This objective has thus far been met with measurement and analysis of novice (i.e., university student) participants' performance on critical NPP tasks. It has since been determined that additional testing using an expert population is necessary to further expand upon and validate the initial results of work performed under this Task Order. The purpose of the current modification to Task Order 2 is to continue this same work by adding an additional task to perform the same data collection activity but expand the participant pool to include former NPP operators. Some modification to the training and participant materials to accommodate an expert participant population will be necessary. The primary location of the data collection shall be changed from UCF to the NRC White Flint Facility. It continues to be necessary to have the incumbent contractor perform all data collection and analysis activities due to their expertise and unique skills for the measurement of human performance and in accordance with the NRC's Human Research Subjects Policy described in a memo titled, "Protection of human research subjects at the NRC" (ML13056A119). Accordingly, Task 7 as described below is added to the Statement of Work for Task Order 2: NRC-HQ-12-C-04-0058 NRC-HQ-60-14-T-0001.

3. Purpose

Add Task 7 to Task Order 2 to conduct a data validation study using former NPP operators as participants. The purpose of this task is to validate data collected under this base contract by running a similar, but amended as necessary, study to those conducted previously under Task Order 2 thus far, but using former NPP operators as the participant pool. The validation study will be conducted primarily at the NRC White Flint Facility, and if necessary, the UCF facility. This task includes but is not limited to working with the NRC staff to implement any necessary adjustments to the experimental design, any necessary pilot testing, protocol, and participant training, carrying-out the human performance data collection, performing a data analysis and providing a technical letter report reporting the methodology, analysis, results, and discussion insights. All materials will be developed based on input from the NRC and subject to NRC review and approval.

4. Specific tasks

Contractors shall perform the following subtasks to achieve this purpose:

7a. Update as necessary training material, methodology, experimental protocol and conduct any necessary pilot testing to accommodate NPP operator population based on input from NRC.

Deliverables: Updated training materials, Methodology in form of Task Letter Report
7b. Write a technical report that details the experimental methodology. The contractor shall then deliver a draft and final report for NRC review and comment; the contractor shall revise the report based on the feedback received from the NRC.

Deliverables: technical letter report

7c. Carry-out human performance data collection

The purpose of this subtask is to run experiments and collect data at the NRC White Flint location and, if necessary, at the UCF location.

Milestones:

Completion and reporting of pilot testing if determined to be necessary in light of research design needs. Determination will be made via discussions between COR and contractor;

Completion of Data Collection

7d. Data Analysis

The purpose of this subtask is to organize and analyze the data collected in subtask 7c. This subtask will involve compiling the data in usable format (SPSS or excel data files), creating a codebook to document the contents of the data files, analyzing the data and reporting the results. Contractors shall perform the following subtasks in order to achieve this purpose:

7d1: Compile data files in excel or SPSS format. The contractor shall provide copies of all data files to the NRC (files should not contain any unique identifiers for individual participants; e.g. name, student number, etc.). Content of data files are subject to NRC review and approval.

7d2: Create codebook specifying the structure, contents, and layout of the data files. The contractor will determine the exact content and format of the codebook based on discussion with and input from the NRC and subject to NRC approval.

5. Deliverables and Delivery Schedule

Deliverables: Modify the existing training materials for the purpose of use with a former operator population while retaining the original materials for use with a novice population; Methodology as a Task Letter Report; Cleaned data files; Codebook; and Final Task Letter Report to NRC describing the final methodology, data analysis, results and discussion.
