Dear Mr. Hickman,

We have noted in regulatory correspondence that the Zion Station licensee, Zion Solutions LLC, has a pending request on file for approval of the Zion License Termination Plan.

Pursuant to the attached and our recently communicated issue (by email) and a number of NRC public meeting stated concerns posed to both you and Mr. Bruce Watson - Chief, Reactor Decommissioning Branch that have gone unanswered, we respectfully request that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission defer until such time as reasonable publically stated concerns are addressed before advancing any decision to terminate the Zion Station's license by accepting the pending License Termination plan.

We note that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission is still in the process of accepting additional information from the licensee in its continuing evaluation but see that only part of that which is currently being submitted addresses the public's stated concerns regarding the licensing spectrum of the Decommissioning and Site Rehabilitation. We look forward to working with the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and its staff to clear these voids and omissions.
