On behalf of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, I extend our congratulations to the State of Alabama on its 50th anniversary of becoming an Agreement State. On July 25, 1966, Governor George C. Wallace entered into an Agreement with the Atomic Energy Commission to assume regulatory responsibility for certain radioactive materials under Section 274 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Agreement). This made Alabama the 13th State to become an "Agreement State," effective October 1, 1966.
