On June 16, 2016, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) completed a security baseline inspection at your Oconee Nuclear Station, Units 1, 2 and 3. The inspection covered one or more of the key attributes of the Security cornerstone of the NRC's Reactor Oversight Process. The enclosed inspection report (IR) documents the inspection results that were discussed on June 16, 2016, with Mr. T. Ray and other members of your staff.

No NRC-identified or self-revealing findings were identified during this inspection.
