SUBJECT: MEETING SUMMARY: CLOSED MEETING TO DISCUSS CB&I  
AREVA MOX SERVICES REVISION TO THE FUNDAMENTAL  
NUCLEAR MATERIAL CONTROL PLAN, THE CLASSIFIED  
MATTER PROJECTION PLAN, AND THE PHYSICAL  
PROTECTION PLAN FOR MIXED OXIDE FUEL FABRICATION  
FACILITY UNDER CONSTRUCTION IN AIKEN, SOUTH  
CAROLINA

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the meeting was for CB&I AREVA MOX Services (MOX Services) and the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) staff to discuss the revisions to the Fundamental Nuclear Material Control Plan (FNMCP), the Classified Matter Protection Plan (CMPP) and the Physical Protection Plan (PPP) for the Mixed Oxide Fuel Fabrication Facility (MOX) under construction in Aiken, South Carolina. The discussions in the meeting were Official Use Only - Security Related information.

MEETING SUMMARY:

The meeting took place on June 21, 2016, at the NRC's Two White Flint Building in Rockville, Maryland. Attendees included MOX Services, the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards, and the Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response staff. The attendees list is enclosed.

DISCUSSION:

The MOX facility is being constructed at the U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE's) Savannah River site near Aiken, South Carolina. The facility will be owned by DOE's National Nuclear Security Administration and will convert supplies of surplus weapons grade plutonium into more

proliferation-resistant forms by blending it with natural or depleted uranium. Converting the plutonium into MOX fuel will enable it to be used in commercial reactors to generate electricity.

MOX Services has submitted revisions to the CMPP and the FNMCP to the NRC staff for review. The purpose of the meeting was to provide MOX Services an opportunity to present an overview of the contents of the revisions.

#### Classified Matter Protection Plan

The revisions to the plan included: a) organizational changes; b) access authorization form changes and clearances; and c) a discussion of changes to document based on classification guidance. The NRC is currently performing the technical review of the submittal.

#### Fundamental Nuclear Material Control Plan

The revisions to the plan included: a) updates to the plan related to refinements of the facility Material Control and Accounting (MC&A) program; b) Format changes to align with revisions to MC&A guidance documents; and c) document clarifications. The NRC is currently performing the technical review of the submittal and is preparing potential Requests for Additional Information.

#### Physical Protection Plan

The NRC reviewed and approved revisions to the PPP and associated documents that were requested in 2015. MOX Services plans on submitting an additional revision in 2017. The discussions related to potential items that may be included in that revision.

#### Action Items

No regulatory decisions were made at the closed meeting.
