The purpose of this task order modification is to:



(1) exercise Option Year One, thereby increasing the exercised ceiling by \$300,214.00 from \$365,881.00 to \$666,095.00 and extending the POP through July 12, 2017;

(2) provide incremental funding in the amount of \$190,000.00 thereby increasing the total obligated amount from \$365,880.00 to \$555,880.00;

(3) change the Contracting Officer's Representative (COR) from Kamishan Martin to Bernard Grenier;

Accordingly the following changes are hereby made:

- (1) Section B - NRCB040A - CONSIDERATION AND OBLIGATION-COST PLUS FIXED-FEE-ALTERNATE I is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

- (a) The total estimated cost to the Government for full performance of this task order (base and all options) is \$982,153.00 of which the sum of \$909,876.00 represents the estimated reimbursable costs, and of which \$72,277.00 represents the fixed-fee.

The total estimated cost to the Government for the base and exercised options of this task order is **\$666,095.00** of which the sum of **\$617,088.00** represents the estimated reimbursable costs, and of which **\$49,007.00** represents the fixed-fee. The estimated reimbursable cost of **\$666,095.00** includes a travel ceiling in the amount of \$5,500.00.

- (b) There shall be no adjustment in the amount of the Contractor's fixed-fee.

- (c) The amount currently obligated by the Government with respect to this task order is **\$555,880.00**, of which the sum of **\$514,982.00** represents the estimated reimbursable costs, and of which **\$40,898.00** represents the fixed-fee.

- (d) This is an incrementally-funded contract and FAR 52.232-22 - "Limitation of Funds" applies.

- (e) In accordance with FAR 52.216-8 – Fixed-Fee, it is the policy of the NRC to withhold payment of fee after payment of 85 percent of the fee has been paid in order to protect the Government's interest. The amount of fixed-fee withheld from the contractor will not exceed 15 percent of the total fee or \$100,000, whichever is less. Accordingly, the maximum amount of fixed-fee that may be held in reserve is **\$10,841.55**.

- (f) Travel Approvals and Reimbursement - Alternate 1 (Oct 1999)

- (i) Total expenditure for travel may not exceed \$5,500 without the prior approval of the contracting officer.
- (ii) All foreign travel must be approved in advance by the NRC on NRC Form 445, Request for Approval of Official Foreign Travel, and must be in compliance with FAR 52.247-63 Preference for U.S. Flag Air Carriers. The contractor shall submit NRC Form 445 to the NRC no later than 30 days prior to the commencement of travel.
- (iii) The contractor will be reimbursed only for travel costs incurred that are directly related to this contract and are allowable subject to the limitations prescribed in FAR 31.205-46.
- (iv) It is the responsibility of the contractor to notify the contracting officer in accordance with the FAR Limitations of Cost clause of this contract when, at any time, the contractor learns that travel expenses will cause the contractor to exceed the travel ceiling amount identified in paragraph (a) of this clause.

(v) Reasonable travel costs for research and related activities performed at State and nonprofit institutions, in accordance with Section 12 of Pub. L. 100-679, must be charged in accordance with the contractor's institutional policy to the degree that the limitations of Office of Management and Budget (OMB) guidance are not exceeded. Applicable guidance documents include OMB Circular A-87, Cost Principles for State and Local Governments; OMB Circular A-122, Cost Principles for Nonprofit Organizations; and OMB Circular A-21, Cost Principles for Educational Institutions.

(g) This is a cost-plus-fixed-fee task order. The following is the estimated cost and fixed-fee for the base and option years.

(4) Section G is revised to include FAR clause 52217-9 as follows:

"52.217-9 OPTION TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE CONTRACT (MAR 2000)

- (a) The Government may extend the term of this contract by written notice to the Contractor within the term of the contract; provided that the Government gives the Contractor a preliminary written notice of its intent to extend at least 30 days before the contract expires. The preliminary notice does not commit the Government to an extension.
- (b) If the Government exercises this option, the extended contract shall be considered to include this option clause.
- (c) The total duration of this contract, including the exercise of any options under this clause, shall not exceed 4 years."
