This letter is in reference to United States Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) permit application SAJ-2009-02417, FPL Turkey Point Units 6 and 7. In accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969; National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, it's implementing authority, 36 CFR 800; 33 CFR 325: Appendices B and C; and Executive Order #1317: Consultation and Coordination With Indian Tribal Governments, a bound copy and CD of the draft report, "*Draft Environmental Impact Statement for Combined Licenses (COLS) for Units 6 and 7*" was provided for your review and comment in March 2015.

The project, SAJ-2009-02417, has proposed impacts over a large area of Miami-Dade County. Please see the enclosed comments from the last meeting on June 24, 2015.
