**NOTICE OF ERRATA IN INTERVENORS' BRIEF ON REVIEW OF  
PARTIAL INITIAL DECISION LBP-99-13**

Undersigned counsel hereby notifies the Commission and the parties of three errors in the Brief of Intervenors Eastern Navajo Diné Against Uranium Mining and Southwest Research and Information Center on Review of Partial Initial Decision LBP-99-13, Financial Assurance for Decommissioning (August 13, 1999). Intervenors' Brief should be corrected as follows:

1. On page 13, the first sentence under heading "B" is missing the word "which". The complete corrected sentence should read as follows: "Pre-licensing review of decommissioning cost estimates is necessary to satisfy the NRC's statutory mandate to regulate for the protection of public health and safety, which requires the Staff to review an applicant's cost estimates and surety plan prior to licensing."
2. On page 28, in the third sentence of the first full paragraph, the word "unresolved" should be replaced with "uncontroversial". The complete sentence should read, "Similarly, in this case, there are no uncontroversial aspects of financial


assurance, and the matter of financial assurance itself is not a minor procedural deficiency."

3. In the last sentence on page 29, the word "issued" should be replaced with "approved". The complete sentence should read, "Thus, Intervenors are entitled to a hearing on the Applicant's compliance with Criterion 9, before the license can be approved."


