ORDER

On August 20, 1999, the Licensing Board issued LBP-99-30, a Partial Initial Decision in the instant proceeding. The Board there ruled that any petition for review of that decision was "not to exceed 30 pages." Slip op. at 77. This page limit appears inconsistent with the one established in the Commission's May 27, 1999 order, CLI-99-18, 50 NRC 411, 412: "We will allow parties to file a single petition and responses up to 60 pages in length. No more than ten pages, however, may be devoted to any individual partial initial decision." To avoid any possible confusion as to whether the limit on petitions and responses is 10, 30 or 60 pages, I exercise my authority under 10 C.F.R. § 2.772(k) and clarify that the maximum page length for any petition for review of LBP-99-30, or response thereto, is 60 pages.

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
