Intervenor Eastern Navajo Dine' Against Uranium Mining (ENDAUM) and Southwest Information and Research Center (SRIC) requested on August 30, 1999, clarification with respect to the 60 page limit addressed in CLI-99-18 and the Order of August 25, 1999, issued by the Secretary. The parties are advised that the intent of the Order of August 25, 1999, was to supersede the ten page limit specified in CLI-99-18 for each Partial Initial Decision (PID) issued by the Presiding Officer, with a 60 page total requirement for the three PID's issued. Within the 60 page limit, parties filing petitions for review may use more or less than 10 pages to address a single PID. Additionally, parties responding to a petition for review would have the same flexibility in addressing the arguments in the petition.
