Dear Mr. Vala:

In NRC Form 314 dated May 25, 2016, (ML16147A473, including attachments), Dr. Thomas Sanderson, Site Director, contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that he wished to terminate NRC License No. 13-32738-01. In your letter dated July 22, 2016 (ML16207A512), you submitted additional information confirming that all residual licensed material from Bristol-Myers Squibb Company, had been removed from its Mt. Vernon, Indiana, listed on the referenced license – such that any remaining residual radioactivity is within the limits of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* Part 20, Subpart E, and is ALARA.

Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from the Bristol-Myers Squibb Company facilities located at 4401 Highway 62 East, Mt. Vernon, Indiana and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria. Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material are required. Your facilities are suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license number 13-32738-01 is hereby terminated.
