EVALUATION

By application dated February 18, 2016 (see Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML16217A309), the U.S. Department of Energy, Division of Naval Reactors, requested renewal of Certificate of Compliance No. 6386, for the Model No. S3G Core Basket Disposal Container Assembly package. The applicant requested deletion of the S7G core basket contents. Renewal of the certificate does not affect the ability of the package to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71. Staff has renewed the certificate for a 5-year term.

CONDITIONS

Condition Nos. 5(a)(2), 5(a)(3), 5(b)(2), and 8 were revised to delete reference to the S7G core basket contents.

Condition No. 5(b)(1)(i) has been revised to state that the S3G core basket is contained in an S5W Modified Core Basket Removal Container instead of stating that S5W is actual contents in the package.

Condition No. 7 was deleted since it referred to the minimum time between shutdown and shipment for the S7G core basket contents.

Condition No. 11 was deleted since it had expired.

Condition Nos. 8, 9, 10 and 12 were renumbered.

Condition No. 10 was revised to reflect the 5-year renewal term.

The references section has been updated to include this request and delete references specific to the S7G core basket contents.

CONCLUSION

Based on the statements contained in the application, and the conditions listed above, the staff concludes that the changes indicated do not affect the ability of the package to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71.
