SUBJECT: REVIEW OF THE UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA
TRAINING REACTOR EMERGENCY PLAN FOR LICENSE
RENEWAL (CAC No. ME1586)

By letter dated July 8, 2002 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML022130145), the University of Florida (the licensee) requested a renewal of its Operating License for their training reactor. As part of the license renewal process, the Reactor Licensing Branch (RLB) was requested to review the version of the University of Florida Training Reactor (UFTR) Emergency Plan on file (ADAMS Accession No. ML16200A378) dated August 2013. The licensee submitted this version as a complete reissuance of the UFTR Emergency Plan as part of the licensee's efforts to reconstitute the UFTR licensing basis. This version was extracted from a letter dated August 30, 2013 (ADAMS Accession No. ML 13252A141).

The RLB has completed its review of the UFTR Emergency Plan and has determined that the UFTR Emergency Plan is compliant with the following regulations and guidance:

- 10 CFR 50.34(b)(6)(v),
- Regulatory Guide 2.6, "Emergency Planning for Research and Test Reactors,"
- ANSI/ANS-15.16-2015, "Emergency Planning for Research Reactors,"
- NUREG-0849, "Standard Review Plan for the Review and Evaluation of Emergency Plans for Research and Test Reactors,"
- NRC Information Notice 97-34, "Deficiencies in Licensee Submittals Regarding Terminology for Radiological Emergency Action Levels in Accordance with the New Part 20," and
- NRC Information Notice 92-79, "Nonpower Reactor Emergency Response."
