This report contains information required under 10 CFR 31.5 (c)(8)(ii) for transfer of generally licensed devices containing radioactive material.

On Friday, July 29, 2016, 4 radiation sources from Electron Capture Detectors (ECDs) from 4 Gas Chromatographs at Anheuser-Busch, LLC, One Busch Place in St. Louis, MO 63118 were removed by a representative of and transferred to R M Wester and Associates Inc, 215 Indacom Drive, St. Peters, MO 63376 for subsequent disposal. Each of the four sources contained 15 mCi of Ni-63.

R. M. Wester and Associates, Inc. Radioactive Material License Number is 24-20091. The R. M. Wester and Associates, Inc. contact person in charge of this source is their R.S.O. Mr. Robert Wester.

The Gas Chromatographs (model descriptions and serial numbers listed below), containing no radioactive sources, were scrapped.
