Cabrera Services Inc. (Cabrera) is providing this written notification of completion of job activities at the Fords Farm temporary job site. The following information is provided in accordance with License Condition No. 18B:

1. **Temporary job site status:** Cabrera has completed licensed activities and has returned full radiological control to the Aberdeen Test Center (ATC).
2. **Disposition of any licensed radioactive material:**
 - Cabrera took possession of no licensed radioactive material during the course of field work.
 - Three (3) exempt quantity radioactive check sources were used to perform routine response checks and efficiency determinations of field radiological survey instruments and; were removed from site at the completion of field work.
 - Surface contamination surveys were performed on contractor tools & equipment released for unrestricted use from the radiologically controlled area (RCA); all final survey results for released tools & equipment were below clearance/screening levels established for Cabrera's licensed Radiation Safety Program. A potentially internally contaminated sump pump and HEPA air handler were not released from the RCA and are now controlled by ATC pending final disposition.
