I am responding to your letter dated March 28, 2016, which requested that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) approve a new Truck Route designated as No. 255 for transporting spent nuclear fuel from Idaho National Laboratory, Idaho Falls, ID to the University of Texas, Austin, TX.

The NRC has reviewed your application and concluded that the information satisfies the requirements of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR) Part 73.37. This letter constitutes approval of Truck Route No. 255 which will expire September 30, 2021. The NRC expects your periodic review and update of the emergency phone numbers associated with this route. Changes to emergency contact numbers do not qualify as a route deviation or change.
