SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF A PUBLIC MEETING WITH SOUTHERN NUCLEAR

OPERATING COMPANY AND SOUTH CAROLINA ELECTRIC & GAS

ON JUNE 23, 2016

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a Category 2 public meeting with Southern Nuclear Operating Company (SNC) and South Carolina Electric & Gas (SCE&G) on June 23, 2016. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss issues associated with the safety review of licensing actions for SNC's Vogtle Electric Generating Plant (VEGP) Units 3 and 4, and SCE&G's Virgil C. Summer Nuclear Station (VCSNS) Units 2 and 3.

Summary of Meeting:

On June 23, 2016, staff from the NRC conducted a public meeting with representatives from SNC and SCE&G to discuss issues associated with the safety review of licensing actions for SNC's VEGP Units 3 and 4, and SCE&G's VCSNS Units 2 and 3. Specifically, the meeting discussed the proposed changes to the IRWST screen and containment recirculation screen protective plate.

In the open portion of the meeting, the licensees, through their vendor, Westinghouse Electric Company (WEC), walked through the presentation slides, explaining the proposed changes to the IRWST screen and containment recirculation screen protective plate. WEC described that the IRWST minimum screen size is based on the maximum normal residual heat removal system (RNS) flow, which increased from 2320 gallons per minute (gpm) to 2600 gpm in order to account for instrument uncertainty and RNS flow changes from reactor coolant system pressure decreases during a postulated accident. WEC described that the increase in the IRWST minimum screen areas is required to ensure that the design basis for the IRWST screens remains consistent with the results of the screen head loss testing that demonstrated acceptability of the screens and that the proposed increased IRWST screen areas does not increase the risk of debris clogging the screens. The staff asked if the licensees have identified any adverse effect to the RNS flow increase, if RNS flow is preferentially distributed to IRWST screens A and B, and if the analysis performed is still bounding. The licensees confirmed that no adverse effects have been identified, RNS flow was not preferentially distributed to any of the IRWST screens, and that the analysis was bounding. The applicant also clarified that the increase in minimum available screen area does not constitute a physical change, merely a reduction in the margin between the actual screen area and the minimum required by the inspection, test, analysis, and acceptance criteria.

The licensees, through their vendor, WEC, explained the proposed changes to the containment recirculation screen protective plate, noting that the proposed changes include providing additional clearance to facilitate reactor coolant pump maintenance and specifying where measurements will be taken to account for the final location of the plate. WEC stated that the proposed changes do not adversely affect the structural qualification of the containment recirculation protective plate and that the plate remains qualified for its required load combinations. The staff asked when the licensees planned to submit this LAR and if all calculations that support these dimension changes were complete and available for staff audit. The licensees confirmed that the calculations were complete and available and stated that they plan to submit the LAR for staff review in July 2016.

At the end of the open portion of the meeting, there was an opportunity for the public to provide comments and ask questions. All comments and questions were addressed before ending the open portion of the meeting.

In the closed portion of the meeting, the staff and licensees discussed the proprietary figure regarding the proposed containment recirculation screen protective plate dimension change.
