Good afternoon Michelle,

It was great talking with you this morning regarding how New Mexico will proceed with adopting compatibility required regulations so please disregard RATS IS 1993-2 and all RATS submitted recently. As stated in our conversation this morning we plan on revising our regulation as required including 1993-2 RATS through the state's rule revisions as required by New Mexico Administrative Code. The process requires we first meet with our advisory council (i.e., Radiation Technical Advisory Council-RTAC) to obtain their approval of the changes to the regulations. As mention Santiago has informed me that we now have the required number of members in the RTAC to constitute a quorum. We are proceeding to complete the revisions to our regulation by the end of this month, and plan to present them to the RTAC sometime in October 2016, followed by the final presentation to the Environmental Improvement Board in late December 2016 or mid-January 2017 for final approval and adoption of the regulations. Please let me know if you need any additional information.
