**NOTICE OF ERRATA**

Undersigned counsel hereby notifies the Presiding Officer and the parties of two errors in Dr. William P. Staub's Reply Testimony, attached to ENDAUM's and SRIC's Reply in Response to HRI's and the Staff's Response Presentations on Groundwater Protection Issues (April 8, 1999). In the affidavit attached hereto as Exhibit 1, Dr. Staub states that his Reply Testimony should be corrected as follows:

1. On page 2 of Dr. Staub's Reply Testimony, the second sentence of the second paragraph in response to Question 4 should begin, "I do not dispute that the data show. . .", rather than "They show . . .". The complete corrected sentence should read as follows: "I do not dispute that the data show quite clearly that reverse osmosis units operate more efficiently when the contaminated input water is not particularly high in total dissolved solids."
2. On page 3 of Dr. Staub's Reply Testimony, the first sentence of the first full paragraph should begin, "However, Mr. Pelizza . . .", rather than "Mr.







I, William P. Staub, begin duly sworn, hereby state that two corrections are necessary to my Reply Testimony, which was submitted on behalf of ENDAUM's and SRIC's Reply in Response to HRI's and the NRC Staff's Response Presentations on Groundwater Protection Issues on April 8, 1999. Unfortunately, these came to my attention only after I had submitted my testimony. They are necessary to clarify my response to question 4. The two corrections are as follows:

1. On the second page of my Reply Testimony, a portion of the second sentence of the second paragraph in response to Question 4 needs clarification. The sentence should begin, "I do not dispute that the data show. . .", rather than "They show . . .". Corrected, the complete sentence should read: "I do not dispute that the data show quite clearly that reverse osmosis units operate more efficiently when the contaminated input water is not particularly high in total dissolved solids."

2. On the third page of my Reply Testimony, the first sentence of the first full paragraph should begin, "However, Mr. Pelizza . . .", rather than simply "Mr. Pelizza . . .".
