1. Because our system to write licenses has changed, I need to separate your material activity into separate authorizations. Please inform me of the Cesium 137 total activity you would like to be authorized for to support each type device:
 - A. Berthold Technologies U.S.A., LLC Model LB 7440D: Thermo process instruments, L.P. Model 5204
 - B. Thermo Process Instruments, O.P. Model 5201
 - C. Thermo Gemma Metrics Model CB-HI

2. Please inform me of the Californium 252 total activity you would like to be authorized for to support each type of device:
 - A. Thermo Gemma Metrics Model CB-HI
 - B. Thermo Gamma Metrics Model CBX

Please consider the need to change devices or additional sources for future operations when requesting the maximum amount of material on your license.
