Pursuant to 10 CFR 30.34(h), on February 8, 2016, Verso Corporation ("Verso"), on behalf of itself and its indirect, wholly owned subsidiary, Escanaba Paper Company ("Escanaba"), which hold the above-captioned licenses, notified the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission that Verso and substantially all of its direct and indirect subsidiaries, including Escanaba, had filed voluntary petitions for relief under Chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware. This letter hereby serves as notice that Verso emerged from bankruptcy on July 15, 2016. The NRC licensees, and the Escanaba and Quinnesec mills, remain the same.
