Enclosed is a Corrected Copy of Amendment No. 74 to your NRC Material License No. 21-06217-02. In accordance with your August 2, 2016 letter, we noted that we had misinterpreted the name change described in your June 6, 2016 letter, due to an inconsistency between that letter and attached additional information. The name change described in your August 2, 2016 letter has been incorporated into the attached Corrected Copy. Note that we have also revised Items 9.A. and 9.B. and Condition No. 13 to reflect Standard NRC licensing practices.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we may provide appropriate corrections and answers.
