Good morning Mike,

Could I ask that at the next Steering Committee meeting, (but not later than September 1, 2016), each plant that does not have all its FLEX connections installed and FLEX equipment received related to spent fuel pool cooling, be identified? The top most person at that site, (probably a site vice president), should also be identified. Since I have not seen one public word from plants such as Entergy/Indian Point or Entergy/FitzPatrick announcing the arrival and installation of their FLEX equipment, I am starting to get a little worried. It is, after all, more than 5 years since the Fukushima accidents.

And don't forget that sending all that FLEX equipment up within 24 hours will mean absolutely nothing if the connections are not available.

And don't forget, even after FitzPatrick is shutdown, the spent fuel remains on site.

Isn't it time for definite FLEX accountability instead of predictions of probable percentage complete?
