Enclosed is an application dated August 17, 2016, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, from TN Americas LLC, requesting amendment No. 02 to its existing license, XSNM3643/01. The license presently authorizes the export of low-enriched uranium to France for fuel fabrication and then to the Republic of South Africa for use in the SAFARI-1 Research Reactor.

The purpose of this amendment is to change the applicant's name from AREVA, Inc., to TN Americas LLC.

There are no changes to the terms and conditions of the existing license being requested. Therefore, our office is processing this as a minor amendment, and intends to issue the license after the required 30-day review period.
