Enclosed is an application, dated August 12, 2016, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission from AREVA Nuclear Materials LLC, requesting Amendment No. 07 to export license XSOU8780/06. The license presently authorizes the export of 11,000,000 kilograms of natural uranium, in the form of uranium hexafluoride to various EURATOM countries for enrichment and ultimate use in nuclear power reactors or return to the United States for use in domestic nuclear power plants.

The purpose of the amendment is to change the name of the applicant from AREVA Inc., to AREVA Nuclear Materials LLC.

There are no changes to the terms and conditions of the existing license being requested. Therefore, our office is processing this as a minor amendment, and intends to issue the license after the required 30-day review period.
