Thank you for the opportunity to comment in support of the combined license application for these Duke Energy Carolinas nuclear power plants proposed for Cherokee County, South Carolina. I have not made a technical review of the recommendations of the Commission's staff but wanted to take this opportunity to express support for the ongoing development of nuclear energy resources in South Carolina. South Carolina is a nuclear friendly state. In addition to the commercial power plants, South Carolina hosts the Savannah River Site that potentially may become the center for mixed oxide fuel production in the United States.
