Pursuant to 10 CFR21.1101(c) which requires that the licensee periodically (at least Annually) review the radiation protective program content and implementation. The RSO for Bear Dog Enterprises, did not document the required annual review of Bear Dog's radiation program content and implementation. The following are the findings of fact dealing with this violation:

1. The reason for this violation was a misunderstanding that the annual audits had to be documented. They were being performed but not in writing

2. The corrective procedures implemented since the 6/20-21/2016 audit, was the use of the NUREG 1556 Vol 1 Rev2, Appendix E Titled Portable Gauge Audit Checklist pages E-1-E-6. This Audit will be performed semi-annually to verify that the records and gauges are being used correctly.

3. The RSO, has instructed all users of the Portable Gauge to participate annually in a review of Gauge usage and security.

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
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4. Full compliance with 10CFR20.1101© was achieved on July 9th 2016.
